ACTIVE LIVES BOROUGH UPDATE 16/17

Sport England's Active Lives survey measures the percentage of people taking part in physical activity and sport. The percentage of physically inactive people (31%) in Barnet has increased by 5% since 2016 and is 6% above the London average. Barnet has relatively low levels of participation for both the youngest aged group (16-34) and oldest age group (75+) in comparison to London.

PHYSICAL ACTIVITY MEASURE

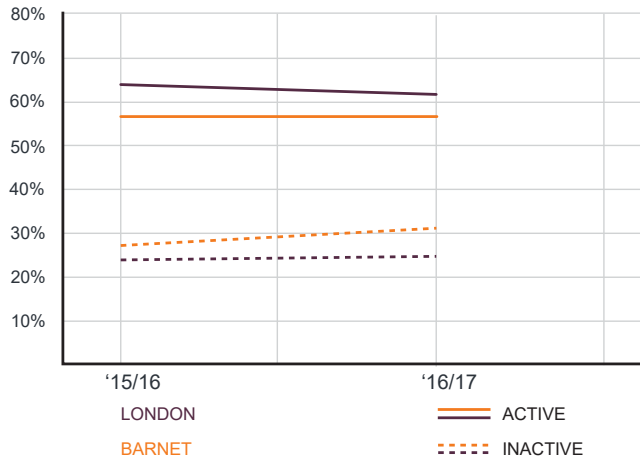
This measure shows the percentage of the population achieving the recommended levels of physical activity* set out by the Chief Medical Officer.

Active: >150 minutes a week

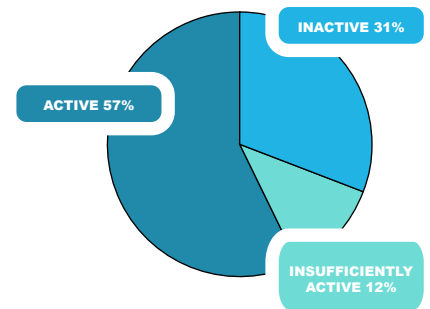
Fairly Active: 30-149 minutes a week

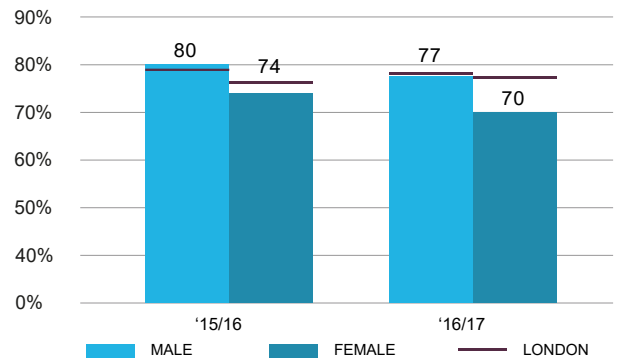


PARTICIPATION AT LEAST TWICE IN THE LAST 28 DAYS

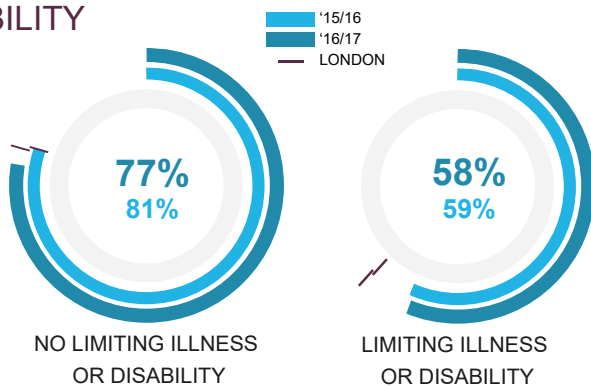

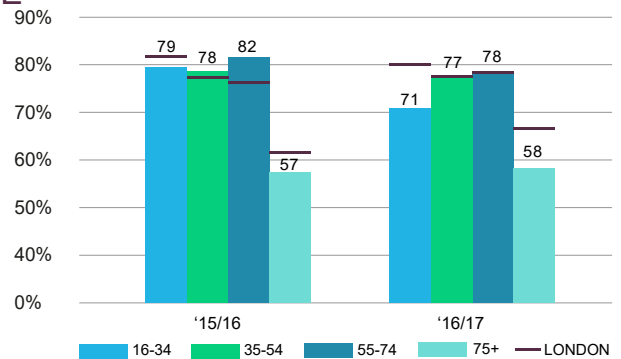

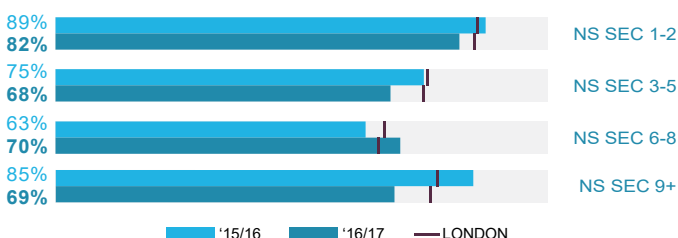
