HAVERING ACTIVE LIVES BOROUGH UPDATE 16/17

Sport England's Active Lives survey measures the percentage of people taking part in physical activity and sport. The percentage of physically active peope in Havering (57%) remains consistent with last year and is below the London average (62%). The most noticeable change from the 2016 results is the 27% decrease in the percentage of people with a limiting illness or disability participating physical activity and sport in the last 28 days. There are also 15% less 55-74 year olds participating in sport and physical activity over the same time frame than when measured in 2016.

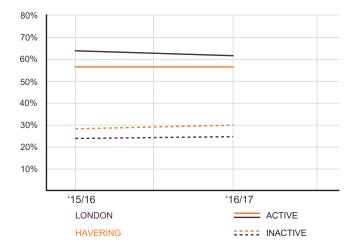

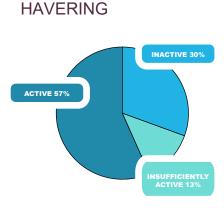

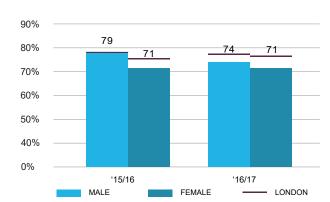


PARTICIPATION AT LEAST TWICE IN THE LAST 28 DAYS

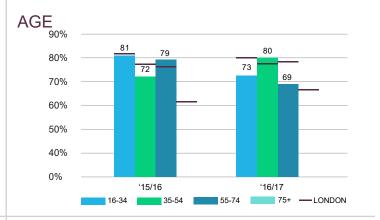

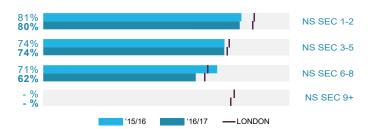
